WHAT IS INCLUDED

This directory has been revised yearly since 1990. It began as an internal document for use in the public relations activities of United Way of Broome County. Soon it also was distributed to United Way’s local member agencies. Other not-for-profit organizations, which were not affiliated with United Way, learned of the directory and requested copies. In recent years the directory has been posted on the United Way website (www.unitedwaybroome.org) and can be downloaded by anyone.

The purpose of this directory continues to be support of public relations activities. All media listed in the first three sections generally accept local information from the public without charge. Some may have very specific requirements (not listed here) for determining what information they will use. Suggested Headline

(Binghamton, NY)--The lead paragraph should focus on the most important point of your press release. Keep it short and simple.

The press release should be double-spaced on letterhead stationery and usually should be no longer than two pages. Keep in mind the five "W's" — Who, What, Where, When and Why.

The format should be in the "inverted pyramid" style with most important items first and least important items last to facilitate editing.

If appropriate, end with a phrase like — For more information, contact (name) at (phone number).

(use at end of press release, underneath last paragraph)
