### **United Way Funds of \$2.4 Million Distributed to Local Programs**

(Vestal, NY) — United Way of Broome County today announced the distribution of \$2,413,563 to support programs addressing identified community needs in Broome County. This money was raised locally during the 2010 United Way campaign and will go to 61 specific programs in the areas of education, income, and health at United Way’s 30 local partner agencies.

“Thanks to the generosity of our community, we are able to provide funding for these programs,” said Mary Ann Wilcox, United Way’s President. “Without hard-working volunteers and a Broome County community generous to its neighbors, none of this would have been possible.”

About 100 United Way volunteers help approve and distribute funding among the organizations. Allocation recommendations must pass through four volunteer review levels: Allocations Panels, the Allocation Steering Committee, the Community Services Division, and the Board of Directors. Funding is based on an analysis of each organization's budget, financial accountability, service and management effectiveness, and ability to meet community needs. In addition, each program is evaluated as to how well it matches United Way's funding priorities.

"Using limited resources to reach as much of the community as possible takes creativity, dedication, and hard work," said Wilcox. "Both the volunteers and the agencies make an invaluable contribution to the quality of life in our county."
