Program Success Story:

Jack began supervised visitation with this agency after his wife Tina accused him of molesting their daughter Allison. Although Jack vehemently denied the allegations, the court felt it was in the best interest of Allison to have visitation supervised in a neutral setting until the allegations could be proven or disproven.

It soon came to light that Tina had serious mental health issues, and there was a history of prescription drug abuse. Allison was very inconsistent and vague about the incidents that she alleged took place between her father and herself. It appeared that Tina was coaching Allison, and that Jack was innocent. Since the matter had not yet come to a satisfactory conclusion, the court placed the family's other daughter Sabrina with her grandparents, who also supervised Jack's and Allison's visitations. Tina was ordered to have visitation at Family and Children's Society with Allison.

The matter took about two years to resolve. After many court appearances, it was determined that the allegations against Jack were indeed false. Custody of Allison was awarded to Jack. Tina, who has not fully resolved her mental health issues, visits Allison at Family & Children's Society.

Recently, Jack expressed his gratitude for the supervised visitation program. He stated "No one believed in me, but your support gave me a glimmer of hope. After that, I felt the scales began to tip in my favor, and I stuck with filing for custody of Allison. I knew I had to do this because I am the only parent Allison has who can give her a good life."
